

Annual Bulk Garbage Clean Up

Flatrock's annual bulk garbage pick up is the week of June 4th. All residents are requested to have all debris on the curb side by June 3rd as there will be **NO DUPLICATION OF ANY ROADWAYS.**

Collection **WILL NOT** include wood, trees, hazardous goods, auto parts, and anything from household renovations such as windows, doors, etc.

The Town of Flatrock will be working with Newco Metals again this year to remove any old vehicles from your property during the week of June 4th. If you would like to take part and have an old car removed FREE of charge please contact the town office at 437-6312 with your name, address, phone number and description of the condition, make and color of the car. The Town Council of Flatrock encourages you to take advantage of this program and get these vehicles that are no longer running removed from your property with no effort or charge to you. Also old tires (with rims removed) will be picked up at the drop off destination at the Town garage, (do not block door to fire truck) on May 22nd. Thank you for helping to keep your community clean.

The town has also planned our Environmental Awareness day to pick up garbage around the property and in ditches for Saturday June 9th. Every bag of garbage returned is a ballot to enter their name for a prize! Once again this year we will have a bike and helmet for the children and a glider/rocker patio chair as a prize for any adult who takes part.
